MITIGATING MEASURES

Site Wet-down Requirements: If the spacing between the crown of the target tree to the crown of the next closest tree is 3 metres or less, then wet-down is required until the ground is saturated to a depth of 2 inches and all exposed roots are well saturated.

Fire Watch: Each work site must receive a fire watch site visit at least every 30 minutes for a period of 2 hours after work ceases each day.

Fuel Reduction, Ladder Fuels, Surface Fuels, Crown Spacing:
