2019 Interface Construction Restriction Exemption Form – Tree Service Companies

WATER CONSERVATION STAGES

STAGE 1: Approved construction exemptions are permitted to be used.

STAGE 2: Approved construction exemptions are permitted to be used.

STAGE 3: Approved construction exemptions are NOT PERMITTED to be used.

STAGE 4: Approved construction exemptions are NOT PERMITTED to be used.

In accordance with Bylaw 2046, 2014 all Interface Construction Exemption applications will be subject to a non-refundable site inspection fee of \$150.

Application Process;

- 1) Present completed application form to Municipal Hall for payment.
- 2) Submit to Whistler Fire Rescue Service along with proof of payment either via Municipal Hall, or by email to fire@whistler.ca
- 3) WFRS will contact you to schedule an inspection of your work site.
- 4) If approved, this form will be signed & dated by the Issuing Officer upon inspection. Please ensure a copy of the signed form is posted at your site.

MITIGATING MEASURES

Site Wet-down Requirements: Each day, before starting the work, midway through the work and when the work is completed, wet down the forested area that is within 10 meters of the work being done for 1 hour each time, or until the ground is saturated to a depth of 2 inches and all exposed roots are well saturated.

Fire Watch: Minimum 2 hour fire watch required after construction ceases each day.

Other Site Specific Requirements including Fuel Reduction, Ladder Fuels, Surface Fuels, Crown Spacing: Chainsaws not to be placed down on combustible surfaces. Chippers must be placed so that the chipper does not create a hazard to surrounding combustibles.
