5 common questions about COVID-19 in Whistler

1. How many cases are in Whistler?

COVID positive case counts for the Howe Sound area, including Whistler, can be found at bccdc.ca/health-info/diseases-conditions/covid-19/data#maps

2. How am I most likely to get COVID?

The main way COVID is spreading in Whistler is through indoor social gatherings among friends and families, even small ones with just two or three people from different households.

3. It's probably just a cold. Do I still need to get tested?

Yes. Even if you are only a little unwell, you may still be COVID positive and can spread it to other people. Visit whistler.ca/covid19 to find out how to get tested.

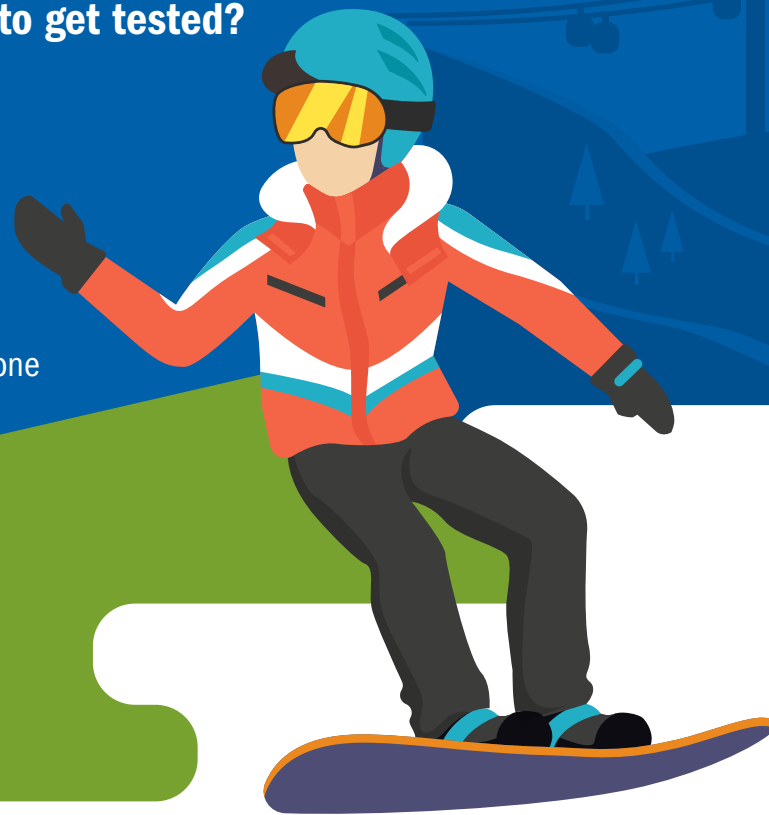
4. How much does COVID testing cost?
