Outside Voice

A: Focus is on the major parks and there are none in Emerald Estates.

Q: Will there be a Valley Trail greenway review?

A: Not included at this time, RMOW concentrated on major parks.

MPSC Cardio room expansion

The project is advancing. Project plans presented. Consultant issued class B cost estimate. Expansion is 1600 square feet.

A: It will remain and the new space is strictly stretching.

Q: Will there be WIFI?

A: It has been addressed and improved.
