

Out-Trip and Activities Consent and Liability Waiver

Throughout the year youth attending the Whistler Youth Centre are offered opportunities to participate in local and out of town day-trips, involving leisure, recreation, entertainment and educational activities. Activities may include but not be limited to hiking, kayaking, paddle-boarding, swimming (rec centres and lakes), bouldering, snowboarding paint-balling, bowling, attending PNE, Cultus Lake waterslides, Bounce, movies, live theatre, and other cultural or educational events.

Youth are supervised during all activities or out-trips by qualified Program Leaders who promote the safety and enjoyment of all participants. Transportation is provided by Program Leaders with appropriate licensing. *The Whistler Youth Centre may also use photos and video from these activities.*

There is some element of risk in any out-trip, sport, or activity associated with this program. By providing consent to participate in the activities of the Whistler Youth Centre, the parent/guardian and youth assumes all risks associated with the activity and releases the Resort Municipality of Whistler, its respective officers, staff and volunteers from liability in claims of injury or property loss/damage as a result of the youth's involvement in the activities.

Expectations for Youth Centre Out-Trips

1. Please hand in your consent forms at least one day before the out trip is scheduled. All trips have limited capacity and are on a first come first serve basis with behavior taken into account. Youth who have been asked to leave the YC within two weeks of the scheduled Out Trip will not be allowed to attend.
2. All Youth Centre expectations apply on out trips: please use appropriate language, refrain from dissing or intimidation and remember that all **youth must not bring or be under the influence of drugs or alcohol**. Feel free to ask a Program Leader if you need explanations or reminders of the expectations.
3. Youth must behave appropriately while on the out trip and especially while in the bus/van (No horseplay!)
