Questions and Answers:

Q1. Page 2, Section 2.2 “Project Deliverables” - For Task 2, quarterly in-person Builder Breakfasts are described. Is RMOW anticipating that the successful proponent will deliver all of these, or could other industry experts be brought in to present some sessions with the proponent organizing?

A1. Yes, industry experts can be brought in to discuss subject matter for these Builder Breakfast events.

Q2. Page 3, Section 2.2 “Project Deliverables”– For Task 7, can you elaborate more on what you are seeking regarding an internal cost management plan?

A2. The goal of the internal cost management plan is that it identifies the internal operational costs associated with implementing and ensuring compliance with the highest tiers of the BC Energy Step Code and Zero Carbon Step Code. The plan should outline the costs associated with additional staffing requirements and resources. There are no specific requirements for the internal cost management plan. The successful proponent would collaborate with the Building Department on the development of this plan as the project progresses.
