Research undertaken to inform the short-term action plan includes:





Age Distribution




Q2 Gender:



Draft Short-Term Action Support and Strongly Support



Themes and observations

- Majority of Forum and survey participants supported or strongly supported all of the draft short-term actions
- Highway 99 Efficiencies received the most comments
- Lots of cross-Strategy comments, with most support and suggestions for improving/increasing free transit, widening the highway and improving intersections

Enough studies, More action

Comments most frequently suggested

- Improve Local Transit (more attractive than automobile)
 - ✓ Better schedules
 - ✓ Lower cost (free)
 - ✓ Special Lanes
 - ✓ Regional transit to Pemberton/Squamish/Vancouver
 - ✓ Train to YVR/Vancouver
- Implement Parking solutions
 - ✓ Park and ride (bus/gondola)
 - ✓ More parking
 - ✓ Pay parking
 - ✓ Resident parking options
- Highway 99 through Whistler
 - ✓ Counter flow lane
 - ✓ HOV/Bus-only lane
 - ✓ More lanes
- Specific suggestion for intersections

Update on Winter Actions



Highway 99 Efficiencies

- ✓ Refined programing of Hwy traffic signals from Function through Lorimer Rd
- ✓ Accident Investigation assessment in progress

Transit Improvements

- ✓ Additional service hours where needed most
- ✓ Reviewing Route 1 Valley Connector and Routes 4/5 Village Shuttles
- ✓ Sea to Sky Corridor Regional Transit Plan
- ✓ Working towards vehicle expansion for 2018/2019

Peak Day Operations Plan

- ✓ Manual control of intersections Creekside to Function and parking lot access
- Communications to promote alternative parking locations and transit/coach travel

Better Parking Management

- ✓ Reduced time limit from 2 hours to 1 hour at Gateway Loop
- Increased enforcement including overnight parking
- Pricing out changeable message boards with parking info on Highway 99
- Pricing out "car counter" and message board for Conference Centre underground

Preferred Transportation Modes

- ✓ Gateway Loop retendered and awarded contract
- ✓ Support car-share offerings
- ✓ Added plowing Valley Trail from Meadow Park Sports Centre to Nesters/Mons through new underpass
