# CONSOLIDATED MUNICIPAL TICKET INFORMATION SYSTEM IMPLEMENATION BYLAW NO. 1719, 2005

# A BYLAW TO IMPLEMENT MUNICIPAL TICKET INFORMATION SYSTEM PURSUANT TO THE COMMUNITY CHARTER S.B.C. 2003, c.26

WHEREAS Section 260 (1) of the *Community Charter* authorizes the Council of the Resort Municipality of Whistler to make bylaws for the purposes of enforcing the bylaws of the municipality;

AND WHEREAS Section 264 (1)(a) of the *Community Charter* authorizes the Council of the Resort Municipality of Whistler to designate a bylaw for the purposes of Part 8 Division 3 of the Community Charter;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Resort Municipality of Whistler deems it expedient to authorize the use of Municipal Ticket Information's for the enforcement of certain bylaws, to designate certain bylaw offenses and set certain fine amounts;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Resort Municipality of Whistler, in an open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

#### 1. Citation:

This bylaw may be cited as "Municipal Ticket Information System Bylaw No. 1719, 2005".

#### 2. Severability:

If a portion of this bylaw is held invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, then the invalid portion must be severed and the remainder of the bylaw is deemed to have been adopted without the severed section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or phrase.

#### 3. General Provisions:

- 3.1 The bylaws listed in Column 1 of Schedule "A" of this bylaw may be enforced by means of a ticket in the form prescribed by the Lieutenant Governor in Council pursuant to Section 273 of the *Community Charter*.
- 3.2 The persons who act in the job positions or titles listed in Column 2 of Schedule "A" to this bylaw are designated as bylaw enforcement officers for the purposes of enforcing the bylaws listed in Column 1 of Schedule "A" opposite the respective job position.

Amended by Bylaw No. 2152 3.3 The words or expressions set forth in Column 1 of Schedule "B1" through "B19" of this bylaw designate the offense committed under the bylaw section number appearing in Column 2 of Schedule "B1" through "B19" opposite the respective words of expression.

Amended by Bylaw No. 2152 3.4 The amounts in Column 3 of Schedule "B1" through "B19" of this bylaw are the fines for contravention of the bylaw offenses set out in Column 1 of Schedule "B1" through B19 opposite the respective amounts.

#### 4. Previous Bylaw Repeal:

The "Ticket Information Utilization Bylaw No. 822, 1990" as amended, is hereby repealed.
