A BYLAW TO AMEND THE RESORT MUNICIPALITY OF WHISTLER LIQUOR LICENCE APPLICATION PROCESSING FEE BYLAW NO. 2224, 2019

WHEREAS the Council of the Resort Municipality of Whistler may, by bylaw, impose fees on the applicant for the issue or amendment of a licence under the Liquor Control and Licensing Act to recover the costs incurred by the local government in assessing the application;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Resort Municipality of Whistler in open meeting assembled, **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS**:

- 1. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the "Liquor Licence Application Processing Fee Amendment Bylaw (Temporary Outdoor Patios) No. 2285, 2020".
- 2. "Liquor Licence Application Processing Fee Bylaw No. 2224, 2019" is amended by adding a new section after section 8 as follows and consecutively renumbering the subsequent sections:

"Despite the above application fees, the fee for an application for a temporary expanded service area in accordance with Policy Directive No. 20-13 of the Liquor and Cannabis Regulation Branch shall be waived."
