## RESORT MUNICIPALITY OF WHISTLER (RMOW) REGULATIONS FOR ELECTION SIGNS

For the full regulations pertaining to elections signs, please refer to the RMOW *Sign Bylaw No. 558, 1987* (complete bylaw available at [www.whistler.ca](http://www.whistler.ca)).

Please note that elections signs are permitted in all zones, subject to the following regulations:

- The maximum area of election signs is 2.0 m<sup>2</sup>.
- The maximum height of election signs is 2.4 m.
- A minimum spatial separation of 1.0 m shall be maintained between any two signs including their supports.
- Election signs must not be displayed prior to the date on which an election is called by the relevant election officer.
- Election signs must be removed within seven (7) days of the date of the election in respect of which they were displayed.
- Election signs must not be displayed on private property or on a public right of way immediately



adjacent to private property without the express consent of the owner or occupant of the private property.

- Candidates are not permitted to place signs on municipal, public or government agency buildings or property, including parks, playgrounds, median strips and parking lots.

Signs within the highway right-of-way need to meet Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure (MOTI) requirements. Please refer to MOTI information here: [www.gov.bc.ca/electionsigns](http://www.gov.bc.ca/electionsigns).
