

## Local Government 101: Decisions In Your Daily Life

### OBJECTIVES

#### Participants will:

- Learn about how activities in our daily lives are subject to local government decisions
- Identify areas in daily life where we can take action

### AUDIENCE

- Age: Young adult learners (including High School students) or adult learners
- Political knowledge: No prior knowledge necessary
- Language: Beginner-intermediate English

### MATERIALS

- “Draw A Typical Day” worksheet
- A Kid's Guide to Local Government e-book

### INSTRUCTIONS



#### Step 1

Using the “Draw A Typical Day” worksheet, draw the journey that you take on a typical day. This may include your journey to school, to work, to a friend’s house, etc.



#### Step 2

Using the kid's guide, identify where and how your local government has a role to play in your typical day. You may choose to group them broadly, or identify specific initiatives such as those identified on the fact sheets.
