Sea to Sky Musician Call-Out: Terms and Conditions

- The application is open **May 1 to 13, 2024**.
- Musicians must reside in the Sea to Sky corridor: Lions Bay to Lillooet.
- Original material: Musicians must prepare a 30-40 minute set consisting of primarily original material.
- Recent releases: Musicians are recommended to have a current album or digital release, either within the last 24 months or upcoming within the next 6 months.
- Availability: Musicians must be available to perform on either Sunday, August 4 or Sunday, September 1, 2024.
- Curated selection: Musicians will be curated by music industry leaders.
- Genre: Considering the diverse international audience of all ages at Olympic Plaza, priority will be given to bands with broad appeal.
- Financial responsibility: Costs associated with travel, lodging, and musician fees will be the responsibility of the musicians. However, musicians will receive a performance fee directly from the event.
- Hospitality: Musicians will be provided with general hospitality during the event.
- The Sunday Sessions is in its inaugural year and is being piloted.
- Please note that due to limited amount of spots, not all applications will be accepted. Only a select number of spots are available.
