



Instructions for accessing and interacting with the Small-Scale Multi-Unit Housing layer in the Whistler Web Map


Launch the **Whistler Map**
<https://webmap.whistler.ca/>




Open the **Layers** tab in the left side panel.



From the Layers tab click on the “All Available Layers” drop-down located in the top of the left side panel.




Choose the “Small-Scale Multi-Unit Housing” preconfigured layer theme from the list.




The selection of the Layer Theme will update the data visible in the map by checking-on the Small-Scale Multi-Unit Housing layer in the Layers list.

A check will appear in the box next to the “Land Use” layer group where the Small-Scale Multi-Unit Housing layer is located.




With the Layer Theme selected could then expand the “Land Use” layer group to see more details, including the legend for the symbology.




If you click on a property within the map, you'll get two records.

1. With the Parcel information
2. With the Small-Scale Multi-Unit Housing information

Use the drop-down in the pop-up to jump between the records.



After switching the record in the pop-up drop-down the information about the specific Small-Scale Multi-Unit Housing property will display.



Finally, to search for a specific property there are 3 options.

1. The Global Search Bar
Use this to search by zoning, addresses, or PIDs.
2. Search by Address tool
Use this to search by address.
3. Search by Zoning
Use this to search by zoning.
